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ACTIVITIES SCHEDULE FOR 2003

July Rehearsals at TJHSST

Practices mandatory for percussion, guard and new marchers (affectionately known as “rookies”) Please discuss any conflicts with Ms. Ulrey (Mary.Ulrey@fcps.edu) and your section leader. Returning winds are highly encouraged to attend these practices. Music will be available July 10 for all wind parts. Battery and percussion parts will be available in chunks beginning in early July. Guard work will begin during our summer clinics.

Winds: Thursdays from 4:30-7:30 on July 10, 17, 24 and 31 (Music will be memorized. All music will be available on July 10 at rehearsal.) Section leaders will be responsible for the distribution of materials for their sections, and will also run sectionals throughout the summer and fall to help students learn their music and drill.

Percussion rehearses on Tuesday and Thursdays from 7/8 through 7/31 from 4:30-7:30 p.m.

Color Guard clinics: from 1-6 p.m. on Thursday/Friday, June 26-27; Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, July 23-24-25.

ALL rehearsals will be held regardless of weather conditions. Please dress for outside activity, Bring a hat, lots of water, and tennis shoes (lace-up) – no hi tops, no sandals. You will have a short dinner break – please plan to brown bag a snack.

Who & When:

Monday & Tuesday, 8/11 and 8/12 - 4:00 pm – 8:30 pm. Come one day only for uniform fittings for **all TJMC**. Vets are encouraged to come Monday for uniform fitting.

Meetings with student leadership – no rehearsal

Wednesday & Thursday, 8/13 and 8/14 - 8:00 am – 5:00 pm - Full day rehearsal for freshmen, guard, drum line, and leadership. Section leaders will be tested on music.

Friday, 8/15 - Full day, 8:00 am – 5:00 pm for all TJMC

All TJMC will be tested on music.

Band Camp (*mandatory for all*) **any conflicts will preclude your membership in TJMC!!**

Dates: Sunday, 8/17 through Friday, 8/22

Where: Shrine Mont, Orkney Springs, Virginia

Time: Check in at TJHSST is Sunday @ 9 AM. Return to TJHSST on Friday, 1:00 PM

Note: All students will travel to camp by bus, with a scheduled departure of 11:00 on Sunday. Students should bring a bag lunch. The buses are scheduled to leave Shrine Mont on Friday at 10:30 AM to arrive at TJ at 1 PM. If the buses will be delayed more than 1 hour, a message will be placed on the Band Voicemail – call 703-750-8384.

Post Band Camp (mandatory for all TJMC)

Dates: Saturday 8/23, 8:00 – 3:00 pm – working drill and having formal pictures taken
Monday 8/25 – Thursday, 8/28, 4pm – 8 pm, to be followed by social events

Where: TJHSST

Note: The Student Band Council is planning social activities to be held after the evening post-Band Camp rehearsals – more on this later in the summer. The evening of August 28th will also include a picnic for families and will feature a TJMC preview performance.

Friday, August 29th (mandatory for all TJMC) Time: 7:50 AM. All TJMC will participate in a performance for freshman orientation. Frosh will perform with the band until 9:00 a.m., and then will join the class of '07 for the festivities. All other TJMC members will be dismissed at this time.

Marching Competitions

Marching Band competitions provide us an opportunity to perform for peers from other schools as well as receive qualified feedback from adjudicators. We are planning the following schedule, although it is TENTATIVE at this printing. Members should plan to attend ALL competitions. Our day will begin with a 2-hour rehearsal at TJ, followed by a snack, pack out, and travel. These days/evenings are great fun, but students should plan to clear their whole day, with the exception of SAT days, for which we are accommodating the conflict:

FEE INFORMATION

Costs of participation in the Marching Colonials include a **Marching Band fee of \$500**, the one-time **cost of uniform accessories** (see Uniform Information), and the **cost of any overnight accommodations** for away competitions. Fees can be offset by fundraising credits earned throughout the year. In addition, the Band Boosters can provide some financial assistance if a student would otherwise be unable to participate. Application for this assistance is confidential and should be made directly to the Band Director.

Fees

- **Marching Band Fee - \$500.00** - This fee includes the cost of transportation to and from band camp, camp room and board, a T-shirt, other band camp expenses and a proportionate share of chaperones' and instructors' room and board.
- **Overnight - Estimated at \$90-\$120** - This cost covers the actual cost of one overnight event which typically occurs at the end of the season.

Refund Policy: The policy of the TJHSST Band Program is to refund amounts paid by the student, after deducting the total of (a) amounts directly attributable to the student already spent by the Band Program on the student's behalf (such as nonrefundable per-person hotel, transportation, or registration deposits or fees); plus (b) a fixed amount representing estimated pro-rata indirect costs associated with the trip or event. Indirect costs will be set at \$25 for trips/events of two nights or less and \$50 for trips/events exceeding two nights, including Marching Band Camp.

EMERGENCY CONTACT INFORMATION FOR BAND CAMP

Parents will be required to complete the Fairfax County Public Schools Emergency Care Information form (Form H enclosed) and return it with your fee deposit and other forms. This form allows necessary emergency care. We will have volunteer nurses at camp, and hospital care is available nearby.

Parents must also provide trip permissions and medication administration permission. These forms will be mailed to you about July 20. These completed forms and any medications should be brought to band camp check-in at TJ on Sunday, August 17.

SUGGESTED PACKING LIST FOR BAND CAMP

Please label or mark all items with the student's name!

- **Instrument and music**, accessories (valve oil, reeds, wax, etc.); guard practice flags
- **Shoes** for marching (2-3 pairs). Well-worn, comfortable shoes "ready to be discarded" are best.
- **Socks** – we recommend enough for two-three changes a day (at least 12 pairs!)
- Comfortable marching practice **clothes** (jeans, shorts, shirts)
- Knee, Ankle, Back **braces**, if needed.
- **Bath towel, beach towel**, wash cloth
- **Sleeping Bag or sheets, pillowcase** – Camp provides blankets and uncased pillow, but no other linens
- **Bathing Suit**
- Personal Hygiene Articles (**toothpaste, toothbrush**, etc.)
- Minor **First Aid** items (mole skin, Band Aids, etc.)
- Lightweight **Jacket** – we will bring the raincoats
- **Money** for soft drinks and snacks (there is a little store in town)
- **Hat (Required)**
- **Sunglasses**
- **Sun Screen (Required)** the higher the SPF the better
- **Water Bottle (Required)** – We provide the water. Drinks with sugar are not permitted on the practice field due to their attraction for bees. Water is better anyway.
- **Insect Repellent**
- **Fan**, if desired. There is no A/C, but weather at camp has been comfortable the past two years.
- Optional **sports** equipment (Frisbee, tennis racquet, balls)
- **NO Televisions, Refrigerators, Microwaves, or Valuables, please!**

UNIFORM INFORMATION

The uniform consists of an issued jacket, pants, dickey, hat, and hatbox. The following are required accessories supplied by TJ to be purchased by all first time marchers:

Plume	\$ 10.00
Navy, long-sleeve, official t-shirt	\$ 12.00
Gloves	\$ 5.00 (except Drumline)
Marching shoes	\$ 30.00
Black socks	Purchase on your own

Marchers will pick up their hatbox and accessories prior to the start of band camp on the designated day. Payment to **TJHSST Band Boosters, Inc.** in full for these accessories is required at that time.

Uniform fittings will be held on Monday & Tuesday, August 11 and 12, 4-8:30 pm. Fitting for ALL students will be Monday, 8/11 & Tuesday 8/12 from 4-8 p.m. ANY returning marchers who want last year's uniform need to come in on August 11 to be fitted. ANY conflicts must be clarified with Mrs. Hubel at mommyhubel@aol.com.

The fitted uniform is stored on a hanger in a garment bag labeled with the marcher's name and kept in the uniform closet at school the entire season. The marcher stores the accessories in the issued hatbox. For each performance the marcher will bring his/her hatbox to school and get his/her garment bag from their assigned student uniform coordinator. The marcher will change into the uniform and return the empty garment bag to the proper rack. Uniform coordinators will be assigned to alphabetically arranged groups of marchers. After each performance the procedure is reversed and uniforms will be returned to the rack and will be inspected by the uniform coordinator.

Cleaning is done at the end of the season after all uniforms are returned. This cost is included in the Marching Band fee. Marchers will be pay for damaged or missing uniform parts at the end of the season (see uniform agreement form).

Hat and Hat Box: A uniform hat will be assigned at the time of fitting and a hatbox will be given to each new marcher. Hatboxes are expected to last 4 marching band seasons. Returning marchers who need a replacement hatbox may buy one for \$4.00. The hatbox will remain at home with the marcher throughout the season. The marcher should reinforce the hatbox (directions will be given) and store clean shoes, gloves, socks, thermal underwear (if needed), hat, and plume (packaged in a cardboard tube) in it. The marcher brings the hatbox to school on the day of each performance and takes it home after the performance.

No hatboxes or uniform parts are to be left in the band area after a performance. Tuba players do not wear hats.

Shoes: Each marcher is expected to purchase the standard, black marching shoe (*Dinkles*). We will be taking orders for marching shoes during uniform fittings. Sample shoes will be available to determine the proper sizing. Shoes will be stored in a plastic bag in the hatbox during the season. Shoes must be cleaned prior to each performance.

Gloves: Marchers will purchase special grip cotton, long-wristed black gloves during the uniform fittings. It is suggested that the marcher keep the gloves in his/her hatbox. Drum line does not wear gloves.

T-Shirts: Marchers are required to purchase and wear the official t-shirt under their uniforms. Marchers will be given a new short-sleeve t-shirt at band camp. Marchers may alternate between the short sleeve t-shirt and the navy, long-sleeve t-shirt depending upon the weather. The uniform coordinators will inform the marchers of the correct t-shirt for each performance. Both t-shirts should be kept in the hat box clean and ready to wear.

Plume: New marchers must purchase a plume for their issued hat. Tuba players will not need a plume.

Raincoats: Raincoats are kept separately by the uniform coordinators and distributed when necessary for “wet” performances.

Uniform Parts and Replacement Costs

Marchers are issued TJ uniforms and sign an acknowledgement of receipt. Charges are made for damaged or lost items according to the table below:
